I want to begin by communicating how proud we are of your faithfulness to the mission and heart of God here @ AFC during this pandemic. You have excelled at being the church scattered. We have delivered hundreds of pounds of food, given over 1,000 bags of essentials away, distributed hundreds of N95 masks, blessed both of our local hospital staffs, encouraged our front-line workers with yard signs and so much more! Your staff and leadership are incredibly thankful for the heart of generosity that each of you have lived out during this time. We are blessed and thankful for all those that assisted us in making the needed adjustments quickly so that we as a church could continue our message of holiness to a lost and dying world. As for coming back together you should expect to see a video outlining a visual look at all the changes we have made. We have listed them out as well for your review prior to our first assembly as a group.

1. **Sanitation: *In the interest of you and others safety we will be doing the following. Keep in mind that this is in an effort to maintain cleanliness and sanitation in the hopes to provide you with the safest environment possible.***

- a. We have purchased a sanitation spraying system. The sanctuary will be sprayed between the two Sunday morning services as well as the common areas of the church. All touchable surfaces in the worship center, on the platform including all equipment, as well as all entrances will be wiped down. On Mondays, the entire building will be sprayed as well.
- b. There will be a hand sanitation station outside of every classroom and at all entrances. Some of these sanitation centers will include gloves, mask, and wipes. Children will be asked to sanitize once upon entering a class after having their temperature taken. We will also encourage that everyone sanitize their hands upon arrival.
- c. The nursery will be cleaned as well as during the Sunday morning schedule. The schedule will be a rotating one with one staff member dedicated to cleaning, sanitizing, and taking care of any safety needs. All surfaces and toys will be disinfected after usage and will receive a deep clean following the Sunday morning services.
- d. Children's areas will be deep cleaned following every use as well.

2. **Re-opening process: *In the interest of you and others safety we will be doing the following. Keep in mind that this is in an effort to maintain cleanliness and sanitation in the hopes to provide you with the safest environment possible.***

- a. Beginning May 31, 2020, we will resume our two services.
- b. The pews will be blocked off every other pew for your safety.
- c. For the time being we will not be passing the pew pads but instead have check in stations in the foyer.
- d. All communications such as pew pads, guest cards, and prayer cards will be available online as well as a kiosk in the foyer where you can submit your information. There are wipes provided at each kiosk and we ask that you wipe the kiosk down when completed and discard your wipe.
- e. Sunday School classes will be offered on site and through Zoom. Each class will be equipped with a smart TV, Zoom login, and on-site teacher. They will be virtual and on-site. This is to accommodate everyone whether they choose to be on-site or to worship and learn with us off site.
- f. Bulletins will be available in a receptacle at the sanctuary exits as well as online by using a QR code.

3. Though these changes may seem extreme we are attempting to put everyone's mind at ease. We also want to communicate to you that however you decide to connect with us we are going to honor and respect. Our desire is that you feel safe and secure in your decision making in coming back into the public. Just know we are doing all we can to maintain a clean, safe, and open worship environment for you and your family.
