AFC FUSION NURSERY

Temperatures-

a child's temperature must be taken before entering the nursery classrooms. We will be using a laser temporal scanner that is non-touch to ensure that there is no germ transmission through this process. Any child with a temperature of 98.9 and above will not be admitted into the nursery area. If at any time, during a child's stay with us, they appear to be warm, please re-take their temperature and contact the guardian immediately if their temperature is no longer within the normal limits.

Diaper Bags and Sippie Cups- We will no longer be accepting diaper bags or outside sippie cups into the nursery area. These things have been shown to transmit germs as they have likely come into contact with saliva, hands, floors, etc.. Instead, each parent will submit diapers and wipes to the nursery which will be placed in the child's bin for use. Additionally, we have purchased a large number of sippie cups that can be washed and disinfected per our standards after use that will be available for the nursery kids during their time with use.

Crafts, supplies, and utensils- Each child is receiving their own bin labeled with their name. Within that bin are the crayons, supplies, etc. that they may need during their time with us. This will allow you to still do coloring and activity work with the children, without them sharing supplies. At the completion of their use, those supplies will be returned to each child's bin for the next use.

Masks and gloves- We will continue the use of gloves in changing diapers. However, we are adding the use of masks during your time in the nursery. We have purchased countless masks and they will be available to you upon arrival. Please ensure that you are only putting on gloves during the handling of food, cups, or diapers, as they give a false sense of security and can allow for cross contamination. And please dispose of your mask and put on a new one if a child were to cough or sneeze near your face.

Class ratios- Statistics show that lowering our ratio of kids to classrooms is going to be one of our greatest defenses against the spread of germs. Therefore, we will be running all three nurseries for both services, regardless of numbers of kids or their ages. This means that I can't put forth a hard, fast rule on age divisions as we won't know what's coming in each day. Basically, we want to take the number of kiddos and evenly distribute them across the 3 nurseries, with the youngest group obviously in the infant space. This is a shift in thinking, but will provide us the best possible security measures against germs.

Disinfection- We are providing Covid specific cleaners for the nurseries. That being said, when these products are being used, they require the use of gloves for your protection and the surface area must remain wet for 10 seconds. Please keep this in mind as you see children putting their mouths on things, coughing or sneezing on toys etc., that we want to glove and wipe those items down asap and in the moment.

During the SS hour, the nurseries will have to have a complete disinfecting with these products. This will be conducted by our paid staff. We will also have insured cleaners coming through sometime during that hour to do a last wipe down before the second service kids enter.
